Tara Kunkel, MSW, is the founder of Rulo Strategies and a nationally recognized expert in criminal justice reform, substance use, and public health. A former Senior Drug Policy Advisor at the U.S. Department of Justice, she led the expansion of the Comprehensive Opioid Abuse Program and helped launch groundbreaking partnerships between DOJ and CDC. Tara brings decades of cross-sector experience and has directed over 25 justice-focused initiatives across the U.S. and internationally.

Kristina Bryant, MBA, is Senior Director at Rulo Strategies, bringing 26 years of experience in justice systems, with deep expertise at the intersection of behavioral health and criminal justice. A former Principal Court Management Consultant at the National Center for State Courts, Kristina has led numerous U.S. DOJ-funded projects, supporting policy reform, program evaluation, and cross-system collaboration nationwide.

She is a trained facilitator in the Sequential Intercept Model and Evidence-Based Decision Making, and a national speaker on justice, behavioral health, rural equity, and workforce well-being.

Randall Publisher), and is engaged with communities to help build the capacity to address addiction, mental health, community trauma, and harm reduction.

Mark was the statewide director for the Maine Recovery Friendly Workplace (RFW) program which he founded in 2023 while employed by Pinetree Institute in Eliot, ME, and

Portsmouth, NH. In that role Mark was responsible for building statewide capacity to recruit, train and support Maine businesses as Recovery Friendly Workplaces. Prior to this role, Mark was the Pinetree Director of Community Engagement where he was responsible for development of Recovery Ready Communities in the Seacoast of NH and southern ME.

Earlier in his career, Mark served as statewide program director for the NH Works for Recovery program at Southern NH Services. In that capacity, Mark oversaw outreach and delivery of employment and training services to individuals and families affected by the New Hampshire opioid crisis and helped launch NH's Recovery Friendly Workplace program. Mark had previously served on NH Governor Sununu's Commission as a member of both the Prevention and Recovery Task Forces. Mark and his wife Vivian are co-founders of Safe Harbor Recovery Center in Portsmouth, NH.
